FORMATTED FOR:

ALL, ALL GIRL VOICES, and ALL BOY VOICES

RHYTHM:

To find the proper rhythm, first read-aloud and clap through the text as you go. Each underlined word or word part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout these sections during performance.

VERSE 1

ALL: Goodbye snow,
Goodbye ice.

ALL GIRL VOICES: Burr, shudder, crack, whack!

ALL: No more winter.
That sounds nice!

ALL BOY VOICES: Shiver, quiver, quiver, smack!

ALL: No sneeze,
 No wheeze,
 No more waiting for the freeze.

ALL GIRL VOICES: Burr, shiver, smack, sting!

ALL: With winter gone,
 It must be spring!

VERSE 2

ALL: Rain falling,
 April Showers.

ALL BOY VOICES: Drip, drop, drip, drop!

ALL: Rain soaking
 All the flowers.

ALL GIRL VOICES: Plip, plop, plip, plop!

ALL: Frogs croak,
 Rains soak,
 Watering the elm and oak.

ALL BOY VOICES: Drip, drop, dong, ding!

ALL: With all the rain
 It must be spring!

VERSE 3

ALL: Little chicks,
Peck and peep.

ALL GIRL VOICES: Peck, peck, peck, peep!

ALL: Leaping after
Newborn sheep.

ALL BOY VOICES: Leap, leap, leap, cheep!

ALL: Bees hum,
Robins come,
Looking for a worm or crumb.

ALL GIRLS VOICES: Cheep, peep, chirp, sing!

ALL: With all this noise
It must be spring!
