

CH-31: The Holidays Are Coming!

(Or "Christmas is Coming!")

A Shared Reading Script Featuring Choral Reading and Solo Reader Parts for Beginning Readers By Lois Walker

CAST: 2 Girl Solo Readers, 2 Boy Solo Readers,

Readers Chorus: unlimited number

READING PARTS FOR: Solo Readers, All Girls in Unison,

All Boys in Unison, All Chorus

NOTE: This Shared Reading script is based upon an old English Nursery

Rhyme: "Christmas is Coming".

Christmas is coming, the geese are getting fat Please to put a penny in the old man's hat; If you haven't got a penny, a ha'penny will do, If you haven't got a ha'penny then God bless you!

The words of the nursery rhyme "Christmas is Coming" are historically associated with the traditional English Christmas celebration and the serving of geese for the Christmas feast. The meaning that was conveyed to children through this rhyme was that during this festive period, each should give to charity, according to their means.

ESTABLISHING THE RHYTHM

To find the proper rhythm for this reading, first read-aloud and clap through the sections as you go. Each underlined word or word part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout the reading during performance.

Girl Solo Reader 1: The <u>holidays</u> are <u>coming</u>.

(Or "Christmas is coming").

Boy Solo Reader 2: The <u>tur</u>key's getting <u>fat</u>.

Girl Solo Reader 3: <u>Please</u> put a <u>pen</u>ny

Boy Solo Reader 4: In the old man's hat.

ALL GIRLS: <u>Please put a penny</u>,

Any old penny,

<u>Please</u> put a <u>pen</u>ny In the <u>old</u> man's <u>hat!</u>

ALL: <u>Make</u> the hat <u>jing</u>le,

Make the hat tingle, Jingle, tingle, penny In the old man's hat!

ALL BOYS: We haven't got a penny!

ALL GIRLS: Is this true?

ALL BOYS: We <u>have</u>n't got a <u>pen</u>ny!

Girl Solo Reader 1: Then a <u>can</u>dy cane will <u>do</u>.

ALL BOYS: <u>Please</u> put a <u>can</u>dy,

Any old candy,

<u>Please</u> put a <u>can</u>dy In the old man's hat!

ALL: <u>Make</u> the hat <u>sweet</u>,

Give him a treat.

Sweet, treat, sticky

In the old man's hat!

ALL GIRLS: We <u>have</u>n't got a <u>can</u>dy.

ALL BOYS: <u>Is</u> this <u>true</u>?

ALL GIRLS: <u>We</u> haven't got a <u>can</u>dy.

Boy Solo Reader 2: Then a <u>pre</u>sent will <u>do</u>.

ALL GIRLS: <u>Please</u> put a <u>pres</u>ent,

Any old present,

<u>Please</u> put a <u>present</u> In the <u>old</u> man's <u>hat!</u>
