Teacher/Director Script and Teacher's Guide For Intermediate to Advanced Voice Choirs By Lois Walker

To find the proper rhythm, first read-aloud and clap through the piece as you go. Each underlined word or word part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and performers will not clap throughout the entire piece during performance.

VERSE I

1 MALE VOICES: Mother <u>said</u>,

2 FEMALE VOICES: Go shopping!

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

3 MALE VOICES: And she <u>said</u>,

4 FEMALE VOICES: No stopping!

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

5 ALL VOICES: Have to fill each stocking

(No pause. Solo voice must come in

immediately)

6 SOLO: With gifts for one and all.

(ALL voices take a large breath as solo line is spoken above so they are able to come in immediately with the following lines):

7 ALL VOICES: So we shopped all through the mall,

8 Buying gifts for one and all.

(Quick large breath)

9 We <u>shopped</u> until we <u>dropped</u>

10 AT CHRISTMAS <u>TIME!</u>

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VERSE II

11 FEMALE VOICES: Father said,

12 MALE VOICES: Find a tall tree!

(NOTE: "tall tree" above is said rapidly as though it is one word. Emphasis is on the word

"tall").

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

13 FEMALE VOICES: And he said,

14 MALE VOICES: No small tree!

(NOTE: "small tree" above is said rapidly as though it is one word. Emphasis is on the word

"small").

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

15 ALL VOICES: Something <u>bushy</u>, not <u>pal</u>try.

(No pause. Solo voice must come in

immediately)

16 SOLO: Need a tree to make us proud!

(ALL voices take a large breath as solo line is spoken above so they are able to come in

immediately with lines below):

17 ALL VOICES: So we <u>pushed</u> right through the <u>crowd</u>,

18 Tailing <u>trees</u> to make us <u>proud</u>.

(Quick large breath)

We <u>pushed</u> 'til we were <u>bushed</u>

20 AT CHRISTMAS <u>TIME!</u>

VERSE III

21 FEMALE VOICES: Teacher said, "Good-bye November"!

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

22 FEMALE VOICES: And she <u>said</u>, "Hello De<u>cem</u>ber"!

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

23 MALE VOCIES: "Concert's coming, so remember

(No pause. Solo voice must come in

immediately)

24 SOLO: We must <u>practice</u> every <u>day</u>".

(ALL voices take a large breath as solo line is spoken above so they are able to come in

immediately with lines below):

25 ALL VOICES: So we <u>practiced</u> just that <u>way</u>,

26 Practiced two, three times a <u>day</u>.

(Quick large breath)

27 Re<u>hearsed</u> 'til we near <u>burst</u>

28 AT CHRISTMAS <u>TIME!</u>

VERSE IV

29 MALE VOICES: But with the shopping and the dropping,

(softly)

(Three SNARE DRUMBEATS are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: tap, tap,

tap!)

30 FEMALE VOICES: The pushing and the bushing,

(louder)

(Three CYMBAL crashes are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: crash, crash,

crash!)

31 SOLO VOICE 3: Rehearsing all to bursting,

(even louder)

(Three loud BASE DRUMBEATS are sounded

here in time with your rhythm or beat:

boom, boom, boom!)
