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# WE ARE ANTS! Written and Formatted for Choral Speaking By Lois Walker

This choral speaking version of WE ARE ANTS! involves a variety of speaker experiences. As in most choral speaking, ALL SPEAKERS speak in unison together. But, in an effort to bring needed variety of sound and a composer's touch to the choral expression of this piece, you will find that:

- 1. 6 SOLO SPEAKERS speak special lines.
- 2. ALL BOYS and/or ALL GIRLS speak in unison together.
- 3. ALL VOICES speak in unison together.

#### **REHEARSAL TECHNIQUE**

To find the proper rhythm, first read-aloud and clap through the piece as you go. Each underlined word or word-part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout the entire piece during performance.

**NOTE:** Some occasional clapping *is* required during performance and those sections are clearly marked below.

Verse 1 ----
We are ants

(clap, clap)

Fresh from the nest.

(clap, clap)

No time for "could"

No time for "should"

We rarely rest.

(clap, clap)

**GIRL VOICES:** There are <u>thous</u>ands of <u>siblings</u>

In our <u>old</u> nest <u>hole</u>

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**BOY VOICES:** Working <u>hard</u> for <u>mother</u>,

A true survivor's goal!

**ALL:** Some <u>diq</u>, find <u>food</u>,

Fight <u>foe</u>, tend <u>eggs</u>.

If we're run off our feet

We're truly <u>run</u> off our <u>legs!</u>

Verse 2 -----

We are ants

(clap, clap)

Who can't say "can't".

(clap, clap)

No time to <u>rave</u>,

No time to rant,

No time to pant.

(clap, clap)

**GIRLS VOICES:** We <u>may</u> be <u>small</u>

But we're strong and tough,

**BOYS VOICES:** Carry <u>five</u> times our <u>weight</u>

When the going gets rough.

**ALL:** And we <u>carry</u> home <u>sweets</u>,

In<u>sects</u>, and <u>seeds</u>

**SOLO VOICE 1:** For a little ant's needs!

(See #2 in Teacher Notes)

Verse 3 -----

**ALL:** We are ants

(clap, clap)

Part of the mob.

(clap, clap)

No time to sigh,

No time to sob,

We're on the job!

(clap, clap)

**GIRL VOICES:** And when the job's too big,

**BOY VOICES:** Calls for <u>drastic measures</u>,

**SOLO VOICE 2**: When I <u>find</u> a candy <u>cane</u>,

**ALL:** One of life's large treasures!

**SOLO VOICE 2:** I <u>al</u>ways know <u>how</u>

The story ends.

I <u>mark</u> my <u>trail</u>

And get help from my friends.

(See #3 in Teacher Notes)

Verse 4 -----

**ALL:** Yes, we are <u>ants</u> –

(clap, clap)

And we're not jerks!

(clap, clap)

No time to shirk,

Or go berserk,

We have to work!

(clap, clap)

**GIRL VOICES:** Storing food for the winter

Is the work we do.

**BOY VOICES:** And who <u>eats</u> that <u>food</u>?

Not "you know who".

**ALL:** The <u>larvae</u> eat the <u>food!</u>

**SOLO VOICE 3:** Cold <u>com</u>fort for <u>others</u>.

**ALL:** We live off our fat

And snuggle with our brothers.

## I'M AN ANT! Choral Speaking/Intermediate/Teacher Version

Verse 5 -----

We are ants -

(clap, clap)

And proud to <u>be!</u>

(clap, clap)

We're not spiders,

Termites, or millipedes.

(clap, clap)

**GIRL VOICES:** Though <u>oth</u>er bugs <u>try</u>

To copy or mimic,

Look <u>close</u>ly, you'll <u>know</u>

It's only a gimmick.

**BOY VOICES:** No <u>peti</u>oles <u>near</u>

The thorax and gaster?

**SOLO VOICE 4:** Then <u>grab</u> the bug <u>spray</u>,

And <u>press</u> down the <u>blaster!</u>
