FORMATTED FOR CHORAL SPEAKING/READING

Divide your Voice Choir into two sections. One section will take the child's lines, (VOICE 1). The other section will take the shadow's lines (VOICE 2). The script features lines for VOICE 1, VOICE 2, and an ALL CHORUS.

ESTABLISHING THE RHYTHM

To find the proper rhythm for this Readers Theater poem, first readaloud and clap through the sections as you go. Each **underlined word** or **word** part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout these sections during performance.

NOTE: This script contains the *same* repetitive verse to be read aloud by the ALL CHORUS. A second script containing *varied* repetitive verses is also included in the package so that you may have a choice of approaches.

VOICE 1: <u>Hi</u>! What is your <u>name</u>?

VOICE 2: <u>Hi</u>! What is your <u>name</u>?

VOICE 1: Why <u>did</u> you say the <u>same</u>?

VOICE 2: Why did you say the same?

voice 2. Willy did you say the <u>same</u>.

VOICE 1: <u>Hey</u>, why are you <u>copying me?</u>

VOICE 2: Well, <u>I'm</u> your shadow, <u>can't</u> you see?

I just do what you do.

VOICE 1: You do?

VOICE 2: I do!

VOICE 1: <u>If</u> I stand up <u>straight</u> and tall,

You'll do the same?

VOICE 2: <u>Yes</u>, (pause)

But skinned up knees

Are <u>not</u> my fault!
