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The Town With a Very Special Sound

A Choral Speaking/Reading Script for Primary Readers Teacher Version

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ESTABLISHING THE RHYTHM:

To find the proper rhythm for this Readers Theater poem, first readaloud and clap through the sections as you go. Each **underlined word** or **word** part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout these sections during performance.

FORMATTED FOR:

ALL VOICES, ALL GIRLS VOICES, and ALL BOYS VOICES

ALL CHORUS:

The chorus of this script asks the readers to duplicate many of the sounds that come from trains. Examples: Choo,choo/woo,woo and clickity, clack, clank and clunk. Ask your readers to imitate the actual sounds these words describe. To make the reading even more fun, the chorus can be read to the rhythm of a real train as it chug-a-lugs along the tracks.

ALL: Does a town have a sound,

It's very own sound?

A sound that's different

From all the towns around?

GIRL VOICES: We know of a town

That sounds like a hiss,

BOY VOICES: And a <u>chuq</u>-a-chug-a <u>clank</u>.

Sounds <u>some</u>thing like <u>this</u>:

BOYS VOICES: Chuq-a-chug-a clank,

Chuq-a-chug-a clunk.

GIRLS VOICES: Rattle, rattle, crank

Rattle, rattle, plunk

ALL: <u>Rick</u>ity, <u>Pick</u>ity,

Crackity, smack

Choo-choo, woo-woo,

Clickity, Clack!

BOYS VOICES: Yes, this town sounds

Just like a train.

GIRLS VOICES: Sounds like a train

In <u>sun</u>, snow or <u>rain</u>.

ALL: Sounds like a train

In <u>sum</u>mer, winter, <u>fall</u>.

If not for the train,

Would it <u>have</u> a sound at <u>all</u>?

BOYS VOICES: Chug-a-chug-a clank,

<u>Chug</u>-a-chug-a <u>clunk</u>.

GIRLS VOICES: Rattle, rattle, crank

Rattle, rattle, plunk

ALL: Rickity, Pickity,

<u>Crack</u>ity, <u>smack</u>
