**NOTE:** To read this script, your primary students must be able to read simple words and phrases. The script is formatted for two NARRATORS (teacher or older readers), ALL GIRLS, ALL BOYS, ALL.

## **ESTABLISHING THE RHYTHM**

To find the proper rhythm for this choral piece, first read-aloud and clap through the sections as you go. Each underlined word or word part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout these sections during performance.

NARRATOR 1: Nine green goblins without much sense,

On Halloween day, sat by a fence.

They looked at me through blood shot eyes

And cried,

ALL: "We're hungry for french fries!"

NARRATOR 2: They <u>clim</u>bed the fence, then <u>stare</u>d, and sat.

I <u>asked</u> them what they were <u>staring</u> at.

The first one yelled,

ALL BOYS: "You're full of baloney!

We're <u>starved</u> and want some <u>mac</u>aroni."

ALL: We're <u>Hallo</u>ween goblins! <u>Count</u> us – nine!

We're <u>nine</u>, we're green, and <u>want</u> to dine.

Pouting, brooding, and in the mood

To <u>fill</u> ourselves with <u>food</u>, food, food!

NARRATOR 1: The <u>second</u> jumped to the <u>ground</u> below,

Tripped <u>ov</u>er a rock and <u>stubbed</u> his toe.

Grabbed his foot and began to moan,

ALL GIRLS: "Bring me pizza or I'm going home!"

NARRATOR 2: The <u>third</u> green goblin <u>scratched</u> his head.

Said,

ALL BOYS: "Forget the pizza and bring us bread.

I'll spread that bread with butter and jelly

To help fill up my great green belly."

ALL: We're <u>Hallo</u>ween goblins! <u>Count</u> us – nine!

We're nine, we're green, and want to dine.

<u>Pouting</u>, brooding, and <u>in</u> the mood

To <u>fill</u> ourselves with <u>food</u>, food, food!

NARRATOR 1: The <u>fourth</u> jumped down and <u>sat</u> on a log.

He asked me to find him a fat hot dog.

Then added,

ALL GIRLS: "Don't forget the mustard.

And later I want frozen custard."

ALL BOYS: "I need to eat",

NARRATOR 2: groaned <u>num</u>ber five,

ALL BOYS: "If I don't eat, I won't survive.
