ESTABLISHING THE RHYTHM

To find the proper rhythm for this Readers Theater piece, first readaloud and clap through the sections as you go. Each underlined word or word part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout these sections during performance. After you have established the beat, it is time to start interpreting, experimenting, and having fun with the words by varying tempo, volume, inflection, and expression.

FORMATTING

This script is formatted for 9 SOLO READERS and ALL lines.

READER 1: It was Halloween night

And from under my bed

READER 2: Flew a <u>fun</u>ny little <u>wo</u>man

Who floated overhead.

READER 3

GHOST VOICE: "Boo!" She yelled.

READER 1: "Who are you?" I said.

READER 3

GHOST VOICE: "Me? I'm a ghost!

Aren't you <u>fill</u>ed with <u>dread</u>?"

READER 1: "I'm trying," I admitted,

But you <u>don't</u> look <u>right</u>."

Aren't <u>ghosts</u> trans<u>par</u>ent,

READER 4: The ghost glanced down

At her trendy orange vest,

READER 3

GHOST VOICE: Said, "White's out of style

Say, <u>aren't</u> you im<u>pres</u>sed?

If <u>not</u>, you <u>should</u> be.

Now, show some compassion.

How <u>oft</u>en do you <u>meet</u> a

True ghost of fashion?"

READER 1: Then <u>I</u> looked <u>straight</u>

At her lime green feet:

READER 2: Flip Flops by Gumbie.

They were <u>really</u> quite <u>sweet</u>.

READER 5: The <u>skirt</u> was Lulu<u>le</u>mon,

With "yogo" in place.

READER 6: The <u>shirt</u> was European

With just a hint of lace.

READER 7: On her <u>high</u>lighted <u>hair</u>

Sat a jaunty little cap

READER 1: That I instantly knew

Had <u>come</u> from The <u>Gap</u>.

READER 8: And the look was great -

For <u>ev</u>eryday <u>wear</u>

READER 9: But for <u>scary</u> ghost <u>atti</u>re?
