# **AT CHRISTMAS TIME!**

### Written and Formatted for Readers Theater By Lois Walker

**Reader parts:** READER 1/MOTHER, READER 2, READER 3, READER 4, READER 5/FATHER, READER 6, READER 7, READER 8, READER 9, READER 10/TEACHER, READER 11. (NOTE: READER 11 has only one line, but is asked to do some dramatic movement and a bit of acting).

This script may also be read by 6 readers by doing away with READERS 7-11 and re-assigning their parts to READERS 1 through 6.

To find the proper rhythm, first read-aloud and clap through the piece as you go. Each underlined word or word part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout the entire piece during performance.

# **VERSE I**

1 ALL READERS: Mother <u>said</u>,

2 READER 1

MOTHER: Go shopping!

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

3 ALL READERS: And she said,

4 READER 1

MOTHER: No <u>stopp</u>ing!

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

5 Have to <u>fill</u> each <u>stocking</u>

(No pause)

6 With gifts for one and all.

7 READER 2: So we <u>shopped</u> all through the <u>mall</u>,

8 READER 3: Buying gifts for one and all.

9 READER 4: We <u>shopped</u> until we <u>dropped</u>

10 ALL READERS: AT CHRISTMAS TIME!

# **VERSE II**

11 ALL READERS: Father said,

12 READER 5

FATHER: Find a <u>tall</u> tree!

(NOTE: "tall tree" above is said rapidly as though it is one word. Emphasis is on the word

"tall").

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

13 ALL READERS: And he said,

14 READER 5

FATHER: No <u>small</u> tree!

(NOTE: "small tree" above is said rapidly as though it is one word. Emphasis is on the word

"small").

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

15 Something bushy, not paltry.

(No pause)

Need a <u>tree</u> to make us <u>proud!</u>

17 READER 6: So we <u>pushed</u> right through the <u>crowd</u>,

18 Tailing <u>trees</u> to make us <u>proud</u>.

19 READER 7: We <u>pushed</u> 'til we were <u>bushed</u>

**20 ALL READERS:** AT CHRISTMAS <u>TIME!</u>

# **VERSE III**

21 READER 8: Teacher <u>said</u>, "Good-bye No<u>vem</u>ber"!

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

22 READER 9: And she said, "Hello December"!

(Three triangle beats are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: ding, ding, ding!)

**23 READER 10** 

TEACHER: "Concert's <u>com</u>ing, so re<u>mem</u>ber

24 We must <u>practice</u> every <u>day</u>".

25 READER 1: So we <u>practiced</u> just that <u>way</u>,

26 Practiced two, three times a <u>day</u>.

27 READER 2: Rehearsed 'til we near burst

28 ALL READERS: AT CHRISTMAS <u>TIME!</u>

#### **VERSE IV**

**29 READER 3:** 

But with the **shop**ping and the **drop**ping,

(softly)

(Three SNARE DRUMBEATS are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: tap, tap,

tap!)

**30 READER 4:** 

The <u>push</u>ing and the <u>bush</u>ing,

(louder)

(Three CYMBAL crashes are sounded here in time with your rhythm or beat: crash, crash,

crash!)

**31 READER 5:** 

Rehearsing all to bursting,

(even louder)

(Three loud BASE DRUMBEATS are sounded

*here* in time with your rhythm or beat:

boom, boom, boom!)

32 ALL VOICES:

We were too pooped to pop!

(full volume)

(No pause)

**33 READER 6:** 

Then a single voice said,

(Reader 11 runs across the reading area and stops in front of readers, and faces audience

while delivering the following line):

**34 READER 11:** 

"STOP! SLOW DOWN! GET A

GRIPPPPPPPPP!

(Reader 11 looks around disgustedly and

stomps out of sight)

(Readers look around at each other, smile,

then nod their heads in agreement. They

finally "see the light"))

**35 READER 7:** 

There's a reason for this season,

**36 READER 8:** 

Rise above the push and shove.
