

# The Thanksgiving Escape By Lois Walker

#### **ESTABLISHING THE RHYTHM**

To find the proper rhythm for this script, first read-aloud and clap through the sections as you go. Each underlined word or word part falls directly on a beat. As you read and sing, quietly clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read or sing too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout the reading during performance. Once the readers become comfortable with the rhythm, you can then experiment, improvise, interpret, and make changes to suit your goals.

## CAST Six readers including: Turkey (READER 4) and Piggy (READER 6)
