FORMATTED FOR 16 READERS:

8 Solo Readers, 8 Shadow Readers, and an All Chorus of as many readers as desired.

NOTE: Depending on the size of your class, you can use fewer or more readers than the original 16 by re-assigning a few of the lines.

This version contains a repetition of the same verse each time the All Chorus speaks. A second version contains different verses each time the All Chorus speaks. Both versions are included in this package so that you may decide which works best for your particular readers.

STAGING SUGGESTIONS

Each reader has his/her special shadow. Ask readers to wear signs that say either READER 1, READER 2, etc. or their names: Mark, Mary, etc. In turn, the shadows will wear signs that say either SHADOW 1, SHADOW 2, etc. or Mark's Shadow, Mary's Shadow, etc. Readers and Shadows will stand in pairs during the performance. Encourage gestures, small movements, and facial expressions. The shadows, of course, must mimic everything their readers do!

ESTABLISHING THE RHYTHM

To find the proper rhythm for this Readers Theater poem, first readaloud and clap through the sections as you go. Each **underlined word** or **word** part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast! This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout these sections during performance. READER 1: <u>Hi</u>! What is your <u>name</u>?

SHADOW 1: <u>Hi</u>! What is your <u>name</u>?

READER 2: Why <u>did</u> that sound the <u>same</u>?

SHADOW 2: Why <u>did</u> that sound the <u>same</u>?

READER 3: Hey, <u>are</u> you going to <u>copy</u> me?

SHADOW 3: Well, <u>I'm</u> your shadow, <u>can't</u> you see?

I just do what you do.

ALL READERS: You do?

ALL SHADOWS: We do!

ALL: Shadow, Shadow

If I move from A to B,

Will you move along with me?

READER 4: <u>If</u> I stand up <u>straight</u> and tall,

Then turn around upon my toes,

You'll do the same?

Then do a somersault,

You'll do the same?

SHADOW 5: <u>Yes</u>, (pause)
