A Fairy Tale: The Three Little Pigs Adapted and Formatted for Readers Theater by Lois Walker Cast: 8 Readers, Including Wolf Part, and 3 Pig Parts

READER 1: I know a <u>Lee</u>-Sung <u>pig</u>

ALL READERS: We know a <u>Lee</u>-Sung <u>pig.</u>

READER 1: You could call him <u>little</u>

He <u>is</u>n't very <u>big</u>.

READER 2: He built a small house

Of <u>straw</u> and man<u>u</u>re.

READER 3: It <u>cost</u> one <u>yuan</u>,

READER 4: It <u>could</u>n't cost him <u>few</u>er.

READER 5: Then he said,

PIG 1: "Hey Wolf

Stay away from my door.

This house will keep me safe

Forevermore.

PIG 1: And <u>if</u> it <u>does</u>n't,

One way or the other,

I can always go and live

With my brother!"

READER 2: I know a <u>Lee</u>-Sung <u>pig</u>
