## A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM, Briefly

## **ESTABLISHING THE RHYTHM**

To find the proper rhythm for this piece, first read-aloud and clap through the sections as you go. Each underlined word or word part falls directly on a beat. As you read, clap on each underlined word, keeping the rhythm steady. Be careful not to read too fast!

This is a rehearsal technique and readers will not clap throughout these sections during performance. After you have established the beat, it is time to start interpreting, experimenting, and having fun with the words by varying tempo, volume, inflection, and expression. Be careful not to allow the development of a "sing-song" delivery while rehearsing and performing this script.

## **STAGING**

This script may be staged as either a Readers Theater Reading or as a Traditional Play:

If you are staging it as RT, hang signs around each characters neck telling the audience the name of that character. (THESEUS, HIPPOLYTA, NICK BOTTOM, MOTH, COBWEB, etc.) Since most RT productions do not involve much stage movement, ask some of the characters who have smaller parts to hold up large signs at the proper moments to inform the audience which stage movements are happening at the time. (EGEUS, HERMIS, LYSANDER, AND DEMETRIUS ENTER, - TITANIA EXITS, - TITANIA SLEEPS AND THE FAIRIES STEAL AWAY, etc.).

NOTE: If you are staging the piece as Traditional Theater, simply block your actors as you normally would, and follow the stage directions below.

SETTING: ATHENS AND A NEARBY FOREST SCENE 1 - PALACE OF THE DUKE OF ATHENS

THESEUS: <u>FOUR MORE DAYS UNTIL</u> WE WED; <u>TIME</u> IT IS A-<u>CREEP</u>ING.

IF EXCITEMENT DOES NOT START, I WILL SPEND THEM SLEEPING.

HIPPOLYTA: <u>TIME</u> WILL FLY RIGHT <u>BY</u>, MY LORD, <u>SUN</u> AND MOON WILL <u>SCAMP</u>ER, <u>SO</u> YOU CAN RE<u>LAX</u>, MY LORD, AND <u>JUST</u> HELP ME <u>PAM</u>PER.

THESEUS: PHILOSTRATE, SHAKE THINGS UP; GET ATHENIANS STIRRING

'CAUSE WE NEED SOME PARTY TIME AND ENTERTAINMENT WHIRLING.

BEAT THE BUSHES, FIND SOME PLAYS, ORDER MERRIMENT.

HIPPO, THOUGH I HURT YOU FIRST, SOON YOU WILL BE SENT.

(sings) "YOU-OU-OU SEND ME! OH, YOU-OU-OU SEND ME!"

(Egeus, Hermia, Lysander, and Demetrius enter.)

EGEUS: OH, MY LORD, I <u>HAVE</u> A PROB! MY <u>DAU</u>GHTER WON'T O<u>BEY</u>!

I <u>WANT</u> HER TO MARRY DE<u>ME</u>TRIUS! SHE <u>SAYS</u> THAT'S NOT O<u>KAY</u>!

THESEUS: <u>HEY, HERMIA, LIS</u>TEN TO YOUR DAD! HE <u>WANTS</u> THE BEST FOR <u>YOU!</u> IF YOU DO NOT DO WHAT HE SAYS, I MAY JUST EXECUTE YOU.

HERMIA: <u>BUT I LOVE LYSAN</u>DER, AND <u>LIKE</u>WISE HE LOVES <u>ME!</u>
HE'S <u>JUST AS GOOD AS DEM-E IS, SO WHY CAN'T I HAVE HE?</u>

EGEUS: BUT I <u>PRO</u>MISED HER TO <u>DEM</u>-E, LY<u>SAN</u>DER ISN'T <u>RIGHT</u>!

I MEAN, HE IS A GENTLEMAN, BUT DEM-E AND I ARE TIGHT!

DEMETRIUS: NO <u>DUH</u>, SHERLOCK! ... I <u>MEAN</u>, NO <u>DUH</u>, MY <u>LORD</u>!

IF <u>I</u> DO NOT GET <u>HERMIA</u>, <u>MAN</u>, WILL I BE <u>BORED</u>!

LYSANDER: I <u>LOVE</u> HER MORE THAN <u>YOU</u> DO, MAN! AND <u>SHE</u>'S THE GIRL FOR <u>ME</u>! SO <u>WHY</u> DON'T YOU JUST <u>DROP</u> OUT, AND <u>LET</u> THE LADY <u>BE</u>!

THESEUS: YOUR <u>FA</u>THER'S WORD IS <u>LAW</u>, YOUNG LADY, AND <u>HIS</u> WILL BE <u>DONE</u>.

<u>MARRY DEM-E, OR</u> YOU DIE, OR <u>ELSE</u> BECOME A <u>NUN</u>.

IT'S <u>SORT</u> OF YOUR DE<u>CI</u>SION, THOUGH IT'S <u>NOT</u> AND MUST COME <u>SOON</u>.

YOU <u>MUST</u> DECIDE, MARRY, <u>NUN</u>, OR DIE, BE<u>FORE</u> THE NEXT NEW <u>MOON</u>.

COME <u>HIP</u>PO, WE WILL <u>SEE</u> THE SIGHTS AS <u>SOON</u> AS FIRST I <u>SAY</u>

A <u>WORD</u> OR TWO TO <u>DEM-E</u> AND <u>E</u>GEUS RIGHT A<u>WAY</u>.

(Theseus, Hippolyta, Egeus, and Demetrius exit.)

LYSANDER: OH, <u>HER</u>MIA, HERMIA, WHAT <u>WILL</u> WE DO? <u>YOUR</u> LOVE I MUST <u>HAVE!</u>

HERMIA: I KNOW, I KNOW, LYSANDER! THIS WOUND MUST HAVE SOME SALVE!

LYSANDER: <u>MEET ME IN THE WOODS</u> TONIGHT, NO, TO<u>MOR</u>ROW NIGHT, I <u>MEAN</u>
AND <u>WE'LL</u> LEAVE ATHENS <u>FAR</u> BEHIND AND <u>START</u> OUR OWN NEW <u>SCENE</u>.

HERMIA: OH, <u>I</u> WILL MEET YOU <u>THERE</u>, MY LOVE! AND <u>WE</u> WILL STEAL A<u>WAY</u>
AND IF NO THINGS WILL GO AMISS, WE'RE IN A DIFFERENT PLAY.

(Helena enters.)

HELENA: OH, <u>HER</u>MIA, YOU'RE <u>HAP</u>PY 'CAUSE THERE'RE <u>TWO</u> IN LOVE WITH <u>YOU</u>.

I ONLY WANT DEMETRIUS; TO ME, HE WON'T SAY BOO!

HERMIA: TOMORROW NIGHT WE'RE OUT OF HERE. IN THE FOREST WE WILL MEET
THEN LY AND I WILL SAY GOODBYE TO ATHENS; 'TWILL BE SWEET!

LYSANDER: <u>YES</u>, HELENA, WE'RE <u>OUT</u> OF HERE. WE <u>HOPE</u> YOU HAVE A <u>LIFE</u>.

BUT MEANWHILE SOMEWHERE OUT OF TOWN, I WILL TAKE A WIFE.

(Lysander and Hermia exit.)

HELENA: I TRULY DO NOT <u>WISH</u> THEM ILL, <u>BUT</u> I WISH ME <u>GOOD</u>.

<u>I</u> WILL TELL DEMETRIUS, THEY'RE <u>MEETING</u> IN THE <u>WOOD</u>.

<u>I</u> WILL FOLLOW <u>AF</u>TER HIM; PER<u>HAPS</u> HE WILL RE<u>JECT</u> HER.

AT LEAST I WILL BE BY HIS SIDE, THOUGH NOT POLITICALLY CORRECTER!

SCENE 2 - PETER QUINCE'S COTTAGE (All the workers are there.)

QUINCE: IS <u>EV</u>ERYBODY <u>IN</u> HERE NOW? IS <u>EV</u>ERYBODY <u>MET</u>?

I'D <u>LIKE</u> TO GET US <u>STAR</u>TED NOW. IS EVERYBODY <u>SET</u>?

BOTTOM: <u>TELL</u> US ALL WHAT <u>ROLES</u> WE'LL PLAY; I <u>HOPE</u> THAT MINE IS <u>GREAT</u> OR WHY DID I SHOW <u>UP</u> ON TIME; I <u>SHOULD</u>A JUST BEEN <u>LATE</u>.

QUINCE: OUR <u>PLAY</u>'S A KINDA <u>COMEDY</u>, AL<u>THOUGH</u> IT'S TRAGIC <u>TOO</u>,

'BOUT <u>PYR</u>AMUS AND <u>THISBY</u>, <u>LOV</u>ERS WHO ARE <u>BLUE</u>.

IT <u>SEEM</u>S THAT THEY ARE <u>DEEP</u> IN LOVE, <u>BUT</u> THERE IS A <u>SNAG</u>.

THEIR <u>FAM</u>ILIES HATE EACH <u>OT</u>HER, AND <u>THAT</u> IS QUITE A <u>DRAG</u>.

BOTTOM: OKAY, OKAY, SO <u>THAT</u>'S THE PLAY, BUT, <u>TELL</u> ME, WHAT'S MY <u>PART</u>? IT <u>DOES</u>N'T MATTER <u>WHAT</u> IT IS; I'LL <u>PLAY</u> IT WITH GREAT <u>HEART</u>.

QUINCE: BOTTOM, YOU ARE PYRAMUS; YOU KILL YOURSELF FOR LOVE.

BOTTOM: THAT WILL CALL FOR MANY TEARS; THAT'S WHAT I'M THINKING OF -

THAT I WILL PLAY IT OH, SO WELL; I'LL MAKE IT ALL MY OWN,

AND <u>I</u> WILL PLAY IT <u>SO</u> SO SAD, I'LL <u>GET</u> TEARS FROM A STONE!

QUINCE: FRANCIS FLUTE, YOU'LL THISBY BE, AND YOU LOVE PYRAMUS.

FLUTE: A <u>LAD</u>Y! I'VE A <u>BEARD</u> IN TRAINING!

QUINCE: DON'T MAKE SUCH A FUSS!

YOU CAN WEAR A MASK AND YOU CAN CHANGE YOUR VOICE.

FLUTE: OKAY, THEN, I WILL DO THE PART, BUT I WILL NOT REJOICE.

BOTTOM: NO, NO, QUINCE! I'LL THISBY BE! I CAN DO A WOMAN'S VOICE!

QUINCE: FORGET IT, BOTTOM. YOU'RE PYRAMUS! CASTING IS MY CHOICE!

<u>COME</u> HERE, ROBIN <u>STAR</u>VELING. <u>YOU</u> ARE THISBY'S <u>MOTH</u>ER.

STARVELING: I <u>GUESS</u> I ALSO <u>CAN</u>NOT CHOOSE TO <u>MAY</u>BE PLAY A<u>NOTH</u>ER?

QUINCE: HOW <u>RIGHT</u> YOU ARE! TOM <u>SNOUT!</u> YOU <u>WILL</u> BE PYRAMUS' <u>FATH</u>ER.

<u>I'LL</u> BE DAD TO <u>THISBY</u>. SNUG, THE <u>LI</u>ON

SNUG: THAT'S NO BOTHER!

BOTTOM: O, LET ME BE THE LION, PLEASE! I CAN ROAR NOT SWEETLY.

QUINCE: AND SCARE THE WOMEN HALF TO DEATH SO THEY WILL HANG US

**NEATLY?** 

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BOTTOM: THEN I WILL ROAR SO SOFTLY, THEY'LL THINK I AM A DOVE

AND I'LL BE SO ADORABLE, THE GIRLS'LL CALL ME "LOVE".

QUINCE: I SAID YOU'RE PLAYING PYRAMUS, AND PYRAMUS YOU'LL PLAY!

NOW CAN WE START REHEARSING THIS BEFORE WE'RE HERE ALL DAY?

BOTTOM: NO PROBLEM, QUINCE. YOU GOT IT. DO NOT GET ALL WEIRD.

SO, TELL ME NOW, DIRECTOR, WHAT COLOUR IS MY BEARD?

QUINCE: ANY COLOUR THAT YOU'D LIKE. ABSOLUTELY ANY ONE AT ALL.

NOW, EVERYBODY HAS HIS PART. WE HAVE NO TIME TO STALL,

SO GO HOME AND LEARN YOUR PARTS BECAUSE WE MUST BE GOOD.

 $TO\underline{MOR}ROW\ NIGHT\ WE\ \underline{WILL}\ REHEARSE\ \underline{IN}\ THE\ LOCAL\ \underline{WOOD}.$ 

THERE NO ONE COMES TO INTERRUPT, OR SPY ON WHAT WE DO.

BY OURSELVES WILL WE REHEARSE; ALMOST TOO GOOD TO BE TRUE!

BOTTOM: WE'LL REHEARSE SO WELL THAT WE WILL KNOW OUR PARTS BY HEART,

SO HAUL YOUR BUTTS RIGHT OUT OF HERE, SO WE CAN MAKE A START!

SCENE 3 - THE PALACE WOOD, NEAR ATHENS, TNE NEXT NIGHT

(Puck and another fairy are talking.)

PUCK: WE HAVE A LITTLE PROBLEM HERE; THE KING AND QUEEN ARE MAD.

THEY'RE FIGHTING OVER SOME POOR KID WHO LOST HIS MOM AND DAD.

TITANIA HAS HIM NOW, YOU SEE, AND HE ATTENDS TO SHE,

BUT OBERON, HE WANTS HIM TOO, TO BE LIKE A SON TO HE.

SO NEITHER IS ON SPEAKING TERMS, THAT IS, FOR PLEASANTRIES,

UNTIL ONE OF THEM CHANGES MIND, IN OTHER WORDS, AGREES.

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FAIRY: 'SO WHAT IS GOING TO HAPPEN? WILL WE HAVE A FAIRY WAR?

PUCK: EVENTUALLY THEY'LL SORT IT OUT. YOU KNOW, HONOUR, OBEY, ADORE.

FAIRY: HEY, HERE COMES SOMEBODY! TITANIA AND OBERON.

PUCK: <u>DO NOT WORRY, I'LL STAY HERE. YOU JUST RUN ALONG.</u>

(Titania and Oberon enter from opposite sides and confront each other.)

OBERON: <u>SO</u>, IT IS TITANIA! <u>GIVE</u> THAT BOY TO <u>ME</u>!

TITANIA: NOT A CHANCE, BIG OBERON! I WON'T SET HIM FREE!

OBERON: DON'T <u>START</u> WITH ME, TI<u>TA</u>NIA! <u>I</u> WILL GET MY <u>WAY!</u>

TITANIA: YOU AND, OH, WHOSE ARMY? YOU DON'T SCARE ME, EH?

OBERON: YOU REALLY SHOULDN'T MESS WITH ME! REMEMBER, I'M THE KING!

TITANIA: OH, BE STILL MY HEART! BRING IT ON, BABY! BRING!

OBERON: I <u>CAN'T</u> BELIEVE YOU'RE <u>CROSS</u>ING ME! RE<u>MEMBER</u>, YOU'RE MY <u>WIFE!</u>

TITANIA: REMEMBER, YOU'RE MY HUSBAND! SO, DARLING, GET A LIFE!

OBERON: SO, YOU'RE JUST GOING TO HANG IN THESE WOODS! HOW LONG, MAY

ONE KNOW?

AND <u>WILL</u> YOU TELL ME <u>NOW</u>, BECAUSE I <u>REAL</u>LY HAVE TO <u>GO</u>?

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TITANIA: TILL AFTER <u>THE</u>SEUS' <u>WED</u>DING DAY. I'LL <u>BE</u> THAT LONG, AT <u>LEAST</u> - BUT, FOR NOW, I'M LEAVING YOU! YOU REALLY ARE A BEAST!

(Titania exits.)

OBERON: (shouts) <u>GO</u> AHEAD! <u>SEE</u> IF I CARE! (to self) YOU <u>MIS</u>ERABLE, LITTLE <u>RAT!</u>

WELL, PUCK, MY MAN, YOU HEARD HER. WHAT DO YOU THINK OF THAT?

PUCK: SHE'S CRUISIN' FOR A BRUISIN'; I'D SAY THAT'S FOR SURE,

BUT I <u>BET MY MASTER HAS</u> THE <u>PERFECT CURE</u>.

OBERON: YOU MUST BE PSYCHIC, PUCK, MY MAN, I HAVE THE PERFECT PLAN

AND <u>FOR</u> THIS NICE PERFECTION, <u>YOU</u>'LL GIVE ME A <u>HAND</u>.

THERE <u>IS</u> A PLANT THAT <u>HAS</u> SOME JUICE THAT <u>REAL</u>LY ISN'T <u>FAIR</u>.

<u>DROP</u> SOME JUICE U<u>PON</u> HER EYES AND <u>THEN</u> SHE'LL REALLY <u>CARE</u>

FOR THE <u>CRE</u>ATURE SHE FIRST <u>SEES</u> WHEN <u>SHE</u> FIRST A<u>WAKES</u>.

BOY OH BOY, I AM SO SMART! I REALLY TAKE THE CAKE!

AND YOU'LL BE SURE SHE SEES SOMEONE THAT'S UGLIER THAN SIN

AND SHE NEVER WILL SUSPECT THAT SHE'S BEEN TAKEN IN!

PUCK: <u>MAS</u>TER, YOU ARE <u>BRIL</u>LIANT! <u>I'LL</u> GO GET THAT <u>HERB</u>.

(Puck exits.)

OBERON: IT WON'T DO A BIT OF GOOD TO HANG OUT THE "DON'T DISTURB".

(Demetrius and Helena enter.)

DEMETRIUS: <u>HIT</u> THE ROAD, HE<u>LE</u>NA! YOU <u>KNOW</u> I DON'T LOVE <u>YOU!</u>
YOU'RE <u>REAL</u>LY GETTING <u>ON</u> MY NERVES! <u>WHY</u> WON'T YOU SKID<u>DOO</u>?

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
